Strategies are carefully selected and monitored through a combination of operational, qualitative and quantitative perspectives.

The benchmark for the composite is the Global Allocation Benchmark. It is a custom benchmark that is rebalanced annually. The underlying components of the benchmark and their respective static allocations are: 32% S&P 500 Total Return, 21.6% FTSE World Ex US Total Return, 21.6% ICE BofA Current 5 Year US Treasury, 14.4% FTSE World Government Bond Index Non USD, and 10% Bloomberg Commodity Total Return. The minimum account size for this composite is \$5,000. The CMG Mauldin Smart Core Strategy Composite was created June 1, 2018 and its inception date is July 2017.

Net returns are reduced by all management and custodial fees. Net returns are calculated by reducing gross returns by a model fee applied quarterly using 1/4th of the highest fee. Accounts pay a fee based on a percentage of assets under management. This fee includes investment management, portfolio monitoring, consulting services, and in some cases, custodial services. The annual composite dispersion presented is an asset-weighted standard deviation calculated for the accounts in the composite the entire year.
