## CMG Tactical Rotation Strategy Composite GIPS Report

The CMG Tactical Rotation Strategy seeks to generate returns in all market conditions based on the concept that various asset classes and sectors experience bull and bear markets at different times. The strategy utilizes a proprietary tactical investment model that analyzes various technical indicators to determine which asset classes are in a bullish environment and likely to achieve a positive return. The strategy employs an equally weighted strategic rotation process which allocates the portfolio to the top two asset classes from a universe of six: Domestic Equities, International Equities, Bonds, Commodities, REITs, and Cash. The investment objective is moderate growth with downside protection. The strategy makes investment allocation decisions on a monthly basis. Once the portfolio is allocated, the positions are held and monitored for the entire month.

The benchmark for the composite is the Global Allocation Benchmark. It is a custom benchmark that is rebalanced annually. The underlying components of the benchmark and their respective static allocations are: 32% S&P 500 Total Return, 21.6% FTSE World Ex US Total Return, 21.6% ICE BofA Current 5 Year US Treasury, 14.4% FTSE World Government Bond Index Non USD, and 10% Bloomberg Commodity Total Return. The minimum account size for this composite is \$5,000. The CMG Tactical Rotation Strategy Composite was created September 1, 2015 and its inception date is March 2013.

The U.S. Dollar is the currency used to express performance. Returns are presented gross and net of fees and include the reinvestment of all income. Gross returns are shown as supplemental information and are stated gross of all fees but not transaction costs, dividends, interest income and capital gains. Net returns are reduced by all management and custodial fees. Net returns are calculated by reducing gross returns by a model fee applied quarterly using 1/4th of the highest fee. Accounts pay a fee based on a percentage of assets under management. This fee includes investment management, portfolio monitoring, consulting services, and in some cases, custodial services. The annual composite dispersion presented is an asset-weighted standard deviation calculated for the accounts in the composite the entire year. The investment management fee schedule for the composite from Q2 2017 to present is 2.25%, the highest fee paid by a client. The investment management fee from inception to Q1 2017 was 2.50%, the highest fee paid by a client. Actual investment advisory fees incurred by clients may vary.
